In 1997, Dr. Gazzaniga was elected to the American Academy of Arts & Sciences. He also has the Past-President of the American Psychological Society. He also served on the President's Council on Bioethics from 2001-2009. In 2005 he was elected to the National Academies Institute of Medicine. In 2009 he presented the Gifford Lectures at the University of Edinburgh.
